### Skills Progression Document for Writing

- Jane Considine's The Write Stuff (FS to Y6)
- Jane Considine's Get Spelling (Y2 to Y6)
- Read Write Inc Spelling (FS and Y1)

This document outlines a clear progression of writing, vocabulary, grammar, punctuation, and spelling skills across year groups. It links explicitly to the pedagogical approaches used and ensures alignment with the National Curriculum.

# Foundation Stage (EYFS)

Approach: The Write Stuff & Read Write Inc Spelling (Set 1-2)

#### Composition

- Begin to orally retell stories using complete sentences
- Use vocabulary drawn from books, enriched through The Write Stuff's fantastics
- Attempt to write simple sentences that can be read by themselves and others
- Begin to sequence ideas logically (beginning, middle, end)
- Write for a purpose across continuous provision and structured tasks

# Transcription





- Develop phonological awareness through RWI
- Begin to apply phonics to write simple CVC words and captions
- Use spaces between words with support
- Form most lower-case letters correctly

# Year 1

Approach: The Write Stuff & Read Write Inc Spelling (Set 2-3)

# Composition

- Orally compose sentences using The Write Stuff sentence stacking approach
- Use The Fantastics to develop vocabulary and sentence structure
- Write short narratives, recounts and simple instructions
- Begin using capital letters and full stops independently

### **Transcription**

Spell words using phonemes taught through RWI





- Begin to learn common exception words
- Spell simple days of the week
- Handwriting begins with correct letter formation, starting and finishing in the right place

# Year 2

Approach: The Write Stuff & Get Spelling (Book 1)

#### Composition

- Use ideas from The Fantastics, Grammaristics and Boomtastics to enhance sentences
- Plan, write and edit short pieces of narrative and non-fiction
- Use coordination (and, but) and subordination (when, if, because)
- Explore expanded noun phrases and time adverbials

#### **Transcription**

- Spell common exception words
- Spell more words with contracted forms
- Start using suffixes: -ed, -ing, -est, -ful, -ness
- Learn to use apostrophes for contraction and possession





#### Year 3

Approach: The Write Stuff & Get Spelling (Book 2)

#### Composition

- Write extended narratives with clear structure (opening, build-up, problem, resolution)
- Include dialogue using inverted commas
- Use paragraphs to organise ideas around a theme
- Use The Write Stuff sentence types (e.g., 2A, if, if, if then...)
- Begin to self-assess using writing lenses

#### **Transcription**

- Consolidate Year 2 spelling patterns
- Introduce homophones and word families
- Spell words with suffixes and prefixes (un-, dis-, mis-, re-, pre-)
- Handwriting joined and legible

#### Year 4

Approach: The Write Stuff & Get Spelling (Book 3)

# Composition

Greater control over tone and sentence types





- Use fronted adverbials and commas for clarity
- Explore figurative language (similes, metaphors)
- Write a wider range of fiction and non-fiction genres
- Use planning, drafting, editing, and evaluating independently

# **Transcription**

- Spell increasingly complex words using taught rules and exceptions
- Consolidate prefixes and suffixes
- Understand possessive apostrophes with plurals
- Spelling logs and dictations (Get Spelling routines)

# Year 5

Approach: The Write Stuff & Get Spelling (Book 4)

# Composition

- Write with sustained cohesion across paragraphs
- Use a range of clause structures, parenthesis and relative clauses
- Select vocabulary for effect and precision using The Fantastics and Boomtastics





- Confident use of figurative language, rhetorical questions, and persuasive techniques
- Edit for purpose, audience, and impact

### **Transcription**

- Spell complex homophones and silent letter words
- Use hyphens, dashes and semi-colons in spelling tasks
- Use etymology and morphology to spell unfamiliar words
- Develop personal strategies to correct errors

#### Year 6

Approach: The Write Stuff & Get Spelling (Book 5)

# Composition

- Write for a wide range of purposes and audiences
- Use precise grammar for effect (e.g., passive voice, subjunctive mood)
- Structure writing effectively with clear cohesion and progression
- Apply authorial techniques confidently (symbolism, motifs)
- Edit with a focus on high-level sentence construction and literary effect

#### **Transcription**

- Consistent and accurate use of complex spelling patterns
- Confident in independent proofreading





- Spell words from Y5/6 statutory list
- Understand origins and roots of words for precision

# Whole-School Strategies Embedded Through All Phases

- Vocabulary Development: Core to The Write Stuff through The Fantastics
- Grammar Instruction: Explicit and embedded using The Grammaristics
- Sentence Stacking: Used daily to model high-quality writing
- Independent Writing: Weekly opportunity to apply skills
- Spelling: Discrete daily spelling from FS through to Y6, transitioning from RWI to Get Spelling
