This term Cedar Class will begin with a history topic looking at Significant individuals from history and consider which one we think should feature on a £10 banknote. In Geography, we will be learning about deserts which will link to our non-Chronological writing about Everest. Science will focus on Living things in their habitats, which will also link in with our writing of poetry about dangerous, unpleasant and favourite animals. We will also be writing blogs under the title of Pet Peeves.

In Maths, we will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages and area, perimeter and volume.

PE will continue to be on Mondays and Wednesdays so children will need to be in full PE kit on both of those days.

Homework
